QCDS Showcases Dental Profession at Fourth Annual World's Fair of Dentistry

For the fourth year in a row, the Queens County Dental Society presented the borough's largest dental event, the World's Fair of Dentistry, at Terrace on the Park.

The event ran for two days in September from 8 a.m.–5 p.m. Dentists and dental professionals from all over the tri-state region were able to earn 18 Continuing Education credits by attending. They had the opportunity to meet with and learn from nearly 50 vendors and had a fan-

tastic networking opportunity, for those in attendance, especially during the catered breakfast and lunch.

Admission was open to all dentists, not just those who are members of the American Dental Association. "This was a wonderful opportunity for us to show the value of organized dentistry to those who are not members and to hopefully convince them of the importance of joining the tri-partite," said Dr. Doron Kalman, chairman of the World's Fair of Dentistry Committee. He served as the master of ceremonies along with Dr. Eric Huang, president of QCDS.

Attendance at this year's event was much higher than last year. "We had over 500 people in attendance each day," said QCDS Executive Director Oleg Rabinovich. "Both days sold out and we had to turn away over 50 people at the door who did not pre-register. It was by far the biggest dental event in QCDS history."

Admission to the World's Fair of Dentistry for ADA members was \$120 for one day and \$180 for both days, but was free to dental residents and dental students. "It's very important to have

the next generation of dentists included in the tri-partite, so we invited them as our guests," said Dr. Hemali Ajmera, Young Dentist Committee chair.

From flat screen televisions to gift certificates to New York Yankees tickets to dental equipment, nearly 50 items were

ADA Trustee Report

Latest News from the ADA

CODA

Our relationship with CODA is very important. CODA will host an informational session at the House. The session will focus on the relationship between the ADA and CODA, to assure that our members understand this relationship. To continue our work with CODA, the Board urged the incoming president to reappoint the joint ADA-CODA work group addressing the relationship between ADA and CODA. I serve on this work group and I am also the chair of the CODA Committee of International Accreditation. So far, only two international dental programs have been identified to be eligible to be able to undergo regular CODA evaluation since inception of this program. None of the international dental programs have been accredited.

Busyness

We have a workgroup addressing the issue of busyness It is a complex issue that has affected our members. The workgroup is developing long-term solutions as well as short-term, tactical solutions. The work of this group needs to continue. Dr. Chris Salerno serves on this workgroup and has worked very hard to present some solutions to this issue. Any suggestions from you are welcome.

Closely related to the busyness problem, the Council on Communications has proposed a resolution for the House (Res. 67) seeking \$6.3 million in 2017, and \$6 million in 2018 and 2019, to support a three-year campaign to drive higher utilization of dental services for ADA members. The campaign has four parts. Improved search, providing paid support to assure that the ADA's "Find A Dentist" is the top search result; na-

tional digital advertising, targeting our two key consumer personas; state and local support, providing matching funds and assistance in media buys; and member resources, tools for ADA members to market their own practices. The proposal includes specific success measures so we can see whether the campaign is working.

There is a move underway among a coalition to include a true dental benefit within Medicare and to shape how that will happen. The coalition includes some influential groups, including AARP and others. To date, the ADA has not been directly involved in these discussions. We will be getting involved with this coalition to be able to be one of the influencers.

The ADA has sent a letter to CMS asking for yet another extension of the deadline for dentists to comply with the Medicare Part D regulation requiring dentists to either opt in or out of the Medicare program beyond the current February 1 deadline

Credentialing Portal

The provider portal is live and the initial pilot is done. We will be contacting providers who participated in the pilot but did not complete the process Based on this work, ADA will do what is needed to find out what worked well and what needs to be improved. Our marketing plan is also ready to be implemented. ADA has been addressing various issues as they arise and is slightly behind a preliminary schedule, but work is now progressing well. This is an ADA innovative project, which is a member benefit and non-dues revenue. I urge you to log on and support this portal.
